

OPERATION & TROUBLESHOOTING

1. Unboxing


Post-delivery, check the contents of the package, has the delivered VB-MNT100 arrived undamaged, does it have visible dents or scratches.



2. Checking the contents of the package


The package should contain:

- 1. Handle body 1 piece
- 2. Handle arms 2 pieces
- 3. Bag with the following contents:
 - Allen key 4mm 1 piece
 - Allen screw with countersunk head M6x16 2 pieces
 - Allen screw cap 4mm 2 pieces
 - Plastic washer 20x8.4x2.5mm 2 pieces
 - Plastic washer 20x6.3x2.5mm 2 pieces
 - Aluminum washer 25x8.5x4mm 2 pieces



3. Installation of washers on threaded sleeves


Insert two plastic washers 20x8.4x2.5mm into the handle body. The washers should be placed on the threaded sleeves made inside the body.






4. Insert the arms into the body

Insert the arms into the body so that the 6.5mm holes in the arms match the 8.4 mm holes in the previously inserted washers. Depending on the intended use, the arms can be mounted with the bend facing up or down.




5. Insert the pressure pads into the body

Place pressure pads 20x6.3x2.5mm on the arms and slide them into the body. The holes in the pads should line up with the holes in the body.




6. Screwing the arms to the body

Sets consisting of two washers and an arm are screwed to the body using a conical M6x16 screw. To tighten the screw, use the 4mm Allen key included in the set. Tighten the screws firmly so that the arms move hard inside the body - with clear resistance.



7. Covering the screws

Press the two included caps into the sockets that were previously screwed in.





8. Screwing the mount to the Video Bar

Use the six screws included in the kit to attach the mount to the video bar.



9. Setting the mount arms according to the monitor's VESA holes

Place the monitor face down on a soft and even surface. Place the arms of the VB-MNT100 mount with the PureLink VL-VB300 videobar screwed on the back of the monitor. Fold the arms of the mount so that they align with the two upper or lower VESA holes of the montor.


Depending on the desired installation position, the videobar can be placed on the top or bottom of the monitor

It should be noted that the VB-MNT100 mount is designed to work with monitors from 43" to 98" and with VESA hole spacing from 300x300 to 800x400.

Bottom mounting position






10. Spacers placement

Place two 25x8.5x4mm spacers on the monitor's VESA holes that do not align with the arms of the VL-VB-MNT100 mount.



11. VESA arms mounting

Screw the VESA arms to the monitor with the VL-VB-MNT100 mounting arms set.



12. Hanging the screen on the wall mount or TV trolley

Hang the monitor with the Video Bar and arms mounted on the holder on the wall mount or TV trolley.



13. Locking the arm on the beam

Lock the arms hanged on the beam using locking screws.
